

Privacy Policy

Agrecovery (us, our, or we) is the trading name of the Agrecovery Foundation, a not-for-profit charitable trust registered as a Charity (CC29641).

The use of our website is subject to Agrecovery's Terms and Conditions and the following Privacy Policy. If there is any conflict between this Privacy Policy and the Terms and Conditions, the Terms and Conditions will prevail.

Governing law

We are bound by the Privacy Act 1993. We and our staff are required to respect confidentiality of personal information and the privacy of individuals.

This Privacy Policy may be reviewed from time to time to take into account any updates on laws and technology, changes to our operations and practices, and the changing business environment.

Collection of personal information

We may collect, hold and update personal information in order to verify your identity, conduct business, provide/market/improve services to meet our legal obligations, and for any other purpose authorised by you or the Privacy Act.

We collect and hold personal information about you, clients, contractors, parties we deal with in the course of providing our services, suppliers, and any other person who may come into contact with us.

Means of collection

Except as otherwise permitted by law, we will collect personal information from you directly, indirectly, and through third parties. Some examples on how personal information may be collected is by you logging into and registering on our website, through emails, through telephone calls, in person, from forms you fill out, through registration and attendance at seminars and meetings, using business cards, and through the use of the services and facilities available through our website.

We may use cookies to collect data about each visit to our website. We may use this data to generate statistics about how our website is used. This assists us with understanding what is important to users and to improve our website's performance.

Updating personal information

We endeavour to ensure that the personal information held is accurate, complete, and up-to-date. We encourage you to contact us to update any personal information held about you. You have the right to correct any personal information held about you in accordance with the Privacy Act. A fee may be charged for reasonable costs incurred by us for providing access to your personal information. If a fee is to be charged, we will advise you of any costs in advance.

Use of personal information

We will only use the personal information for the purpose it was collected and is held for unless the personal information is publicly available, you have authorised the use of the personal information, or if the disclosure of that information is required by law.

Storage of personal information

We will take reasonable precautions to prevent the loss, misuse, or unauthorised alteration of your personal information. We may store your personal information in hard copy or electronic form. This includes with third party storage facilities and in cloud storage located inside or outside New Zealand.

Some of these links may request or record information from users or use cookies or other methods to collect information from you. We have no control over the content or privacy policy practices of those sites, and encourage you to review the privacy policies of those sites before engaging in any activity with them.
